Serpiente de palabras

The serpiente de palabras (word snake) activity is a fun way for children to practise two small words that are similar-sounding but different in meaning: me = me/myself, mi = my.

Pupil A starts at the head of the snake and repeats the words as quickly as possible until the tip of the tail is reached. Pupil B times and checks the progress. Pupil A is challenged and stopped if a mistake is made.

Roles are then reversed as Pupil B tries to beat Pupil A's time.

A follow-up activity could be to colour-code the snake's skin according to the two phonics.
